
How to crab fish:

- 1- Go to the butchers and ask for a piece of the waste bone.
- 2- Go to the shop and buy some twine or a thin rope, and a bucket or plastic container.
- 3- Go to a crab fishing spot (see map) and tie the twine around the bone.
- 4- Make sure the bone doesn't float, if it does find something heavy like a stone or a lead weight and tie it onto the bone.
- 5- You're ready to go crab fishing! Throw the twine into the sea holding onto the end piece, wait about 10 min, then bring the bone back up, and look at all those crabs!

How to catch a crab:

Place index and thumb behind the crab as shown in the picture.



Where to catch a crab:

Crabs can be found in the yellow areas, but the best places to go crab fishing are in red.



^{*}Do not forget to fill the bucket with sea water.

^{*}Do not forget to set all the crabs free.

<u>Hint</u>: crabs love hiding in the quay
walls!
